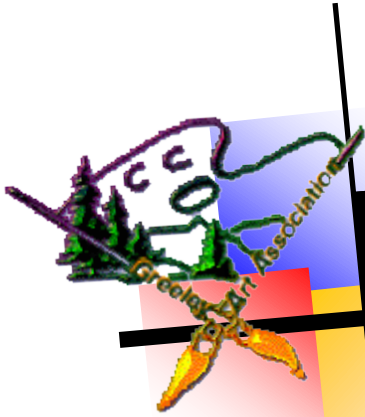

15TH Annual Art from the Heart Show & Sale

February 18–March 22, 2019

WHAT:

Calling all artists to exhibit fine art - paintings, photography, mixed media, dry media, and 3-D. No pre-registration required. Simply deliver your entry on day of delivery to UNC James A. Michener Library Mari Michener Gallery.

Remember to bring:

- Art with identification tags on back (use ones provided or make your own)
- Entry form
- Entry fee

WHEN:

February 18–March 22, 2019 Show dates open to public

February 16, 2019 (Saturday) Deliver artwork to Mari Michener Art Gallery 10:15 AM-12:00 (Noon). Free parking on Saturdays. Library opens at 10 a.m.

February 22, 2019 (Friday) 4-6 PM. Public reception and awards (5:15 PM) Free parking after 5 p.m.

Saturday, March 23, 2019 (Saturday) - Pick up unsold work, 10:15AM-12 (Noon)

WHERE:

All events at Mari Michener Gallery located in James A. Michener Library, University of Northern Colorado at 14th Avenue and 20th Street, 1400 22nd Street, Greeley, CO 80639 (free parking after 5 p.m. and on weekends.)

Hours of Michener Library are:

7:30 am to midnight / Monday thru Thursday

7:30 am to 6:00 pm / Friday

10 am to 6 pm / Saturday

Noon to midnight / Sunday



Eligibility and Requirements:

- ☐ Works must be original and not have been entered in this show previously.
- ☐ Art must be for sale.
- ☐ A 30% commission on sales will be split between Friends of the Library and GAA.
- ☐ Two-dimensional entries must be framed, dry, and wired for hanging (no saw tooth hangers or exposed glass edges.) Finished Gallery wrap with wire hanger is accepted.
- ☐ Entry size is limited to 36" x 44" framed (outside frame), or 78 united inches (length plus width).
- ☐ Sculptors are responsible for installation of their pieces; weight is limited to 100 pounds.
- ☐ No early removal of artwork.
- ☐ No craft items.

Only 100 works will be hung. If the art work is juried out, notification of rejection will be given by telephone prior to 3:00 PM, February 16, 2019 and must be picked up prior to 5 PM that day. We must have a number where we can reach you. If you don't receive a phone call your art has been juried into the show.

Categories:

Prize categories may include:

- Works on canvas - oils and heavy body acrylics
- Works on paper under glass - fluid acrylics, gouache, tempera, watercolor
- 3-D (sculpture, glass, fiber, and fine art pottery)
- Photography and digitally created art. All photographs must be taken by the artist.
- Mixed media where more than one media is used (note: collage must **not** include works from magazines or copyrighted material),
- Dry media - pastels, pen and ink, graphite, charcoal, colored pencil.

Categories with less than 10 entries will be combined at the discretion of the Art from the Heart committee.

Entry:

A nonrefundable entry fee is charged as listed below for up to 3 juried pieces. No extra bin items.

- \$25 for GAA members who have paid their 2019 membership dues.
- \$35 for non-members and members who have not paid their 2019 dues.

Delivery:

Work must be hand delivered to Mari Michener Gallery Saturday, February 16, 2019, 10:15-12 (Noon).

No late artwork will be accepted.

No artwork shipments will be accepted.

Artists are invited to provide a one-page artist's statement/resume to be included in the show notebook

Reception:

A reception for artists and the public is on Friday, February 22, 2019 from 4-6:00 PM at Mari Michener Art Gallery. Free parking after 5:00 p.m.. Promotional post cards will be available at delivery.

Awards:

Awards will be announced at 5:15 PM during the opening reception Friday, February 22, 2019

Unsold Entries:

Pick up unsold entries on Saturday, March 23, 2019, at 10:15AM-12:00 (Noon).

Unclaimed art will be subject to a \$5.00/day per item storage fee. Parking is free on Saturday.

Liability:

Extremely fragile work and work not properly presented will not be accepted. Although every precaution will be taken to assure protection of entries, neither the GAA nor Mari Michener Art Gallery will assume responsibility for loss or damage of any work.

Sales:

The Greeley Art Association and Friends of the UNC Library split a 30% commission on all artwork sales.

Patrons can make purchases all month by contacting Colette Pitcher at Showcase Gallery, 1335 Eighth Avenue, Greeley. Purchases will remain in the show until pick up date.

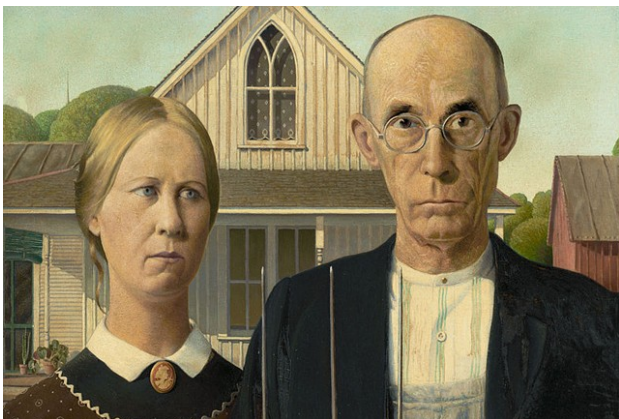

We know this famous painting with interesting models as Grant Wood’s “American Gothic”, which can be seen on view in the collection of the Art Institute of Chicago. To depict, for better or worse, the ideals of rural America, Wood wanted to use his mother, Hattie, as a model for his painting. Wood determined that standing for so long would be far too exhausting for his mother, so he had his sister wear his mother’s apron and pin while posing. For the male subject in the painting, Wood used his 62-year-old dentist.
